

THE FRIAR'S CHAIR



This useful low, fire-side or occasional chair of elegant shape has a tall rounded, buttoned-back and deep bullion fringe to the base and is named after an original iron-frame acquired by John Fowler from Friar's Wells where he was decorating for Lady Ward.

The chair frame is constructed in solid hardwood (beech) and is traditionally upholstered with natural materials and filling and has a coil sprung seat.

Made in the UK in a fabric of your choice.

5.5m main fabric required – 1m contrast fabric – 3m bullion fringe.
