

THE TREFOIL OTTOMAN STOOL



This trefoil-shaped stool with a loose cushion and deep fringe to the base, is a useful alternative to a coffee table providing an additional place to perch or sit in the centre of a seating arrangement.

A piece much used by John Fowler before the advent of the coffee table.

The stool frame is constructed in solid hardwood (beech) and is traditionally upholstered with natural materials and down and feather filling to the cushion (50% x 50%).

Made in the UK in a fabric of your choice.

5m main fabric required – 1m contrast – 4m bullion fringe required.
